# YOUR ROLE AS A TABLE CAPTAIN

## WELCOME A GENEROUS TABLE

Your first task is to extend heartfelt invitations to colleagues, business contacts, friends, family, or anyone that believes youth who experience foster care deserve the same opportunities to thrive as their peers.
